

HOW TO CLEAN YOUR PANASONIC WIRELESS MICROPHONES

Cleaning Professional Audio equipment is important, particularly when you have multiple operators using the gear. Panasonic would like to share best practices for cleaning the **WX-ST200** Wireless Handheld Microphone and **WX-ST400** Lavalier Microphone + Wireless Bodypack.

RECOMMENDED METHODS AND BEST PRACTICES FOR CLEANING PANASONIC WIRELESS MICROPHONES



- If the product surface is extremely dirty, soak a soft cloth in a neutral detergent diluted with water and squeeze firmly before use.
- Gently wipe the detergent ingredients off the microphone with a soft, dry cloth.
- If the battery electrodes or the terminals inside the battery cover become dirty, wipe with a dry, soft cloth.
- The terminals inside the battery cover are liable to get dirty. Wipe with ethyl alcohol regularly.
- Do not spray liquid, such as disinfectant, directly on the microphone as it may cause damage.
- Do not use volatile substances/solvent such as benzine or thinner, or an abrasive such as metal polish, as it may deform, discolor or plate equipment.
- When using a chemical cloth, follow its precautions.
- We do not recommend a regular thermal treatment of our microphones, transmitters, or receivers.
